




IN THE BEGINNING OF XXI

IoTXchange network, within the scope of **URBACT III**, is a project led by the Municipality of Fundão and brings together seven European cities and one university. Its main objective is to encourage the use of digital solutions and IoT (Internet of Things) technology to improve the quality of life in small and medium-sized towns in the EU.



Metacity network, within the scope of **URBACT IV**, is a project led by the Municipality of and which brings Fundão together 8 European cities, one university and one research organisation. Metacity aims to increase competitiveness small and median tech-aware benefiting from cities, opportunity to enhance service efficiency and citizen satisfaction provided by the metaverse.



MED-WET, within the scope of PRIMA. aims to improve irrigation efficiency in the Mediterranean region in a context marked by climate change and extreme drought. MED-WET aims to develop innovative irrigation systems and to use low-cost solutions, with natural and regionally available materials (low technology, low energy, low budget, easy to use).



PLENTY-LIFE seeks to empower small and medium-sized cities in integrated urban energy planning to enable them to develop and monitor long-term sustainable energy and climate plans, with the aim of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050. The strategies developed by the consortium will be tested in four countries, namely Austria, Italy, Portugal and Romania, with Fundão being the pilot territory in Portugal.



"Decentralise Portugal with Blockchain" agenda is creating a national blockchain industry. The results of these partnerships, with an investment of over 72 million euros, will allow the launch of 26 products with high export scalability potential. and The Municipality of Fundão is a member of this consortium, asserting the territory as living laboratory for the experimentation of new solutions using blockchain technology for multiple purposes, namely the traceability of endogenous products, carbon offsetting, multi-company loyalty programmes, among others.



The Municipality of Fundão integrates the **Route 25** consortium, as a pilot territory, the only Mobilizing Agenda project approved in the mobility field. project aims to develop The autonomous, shared, and collaborative mobility solutions, aligned with the needs of low-density territories like Fundão and with projects to promote soft mobility in the city.




FARCLIMATE will address the difficult challenges of developing and expanding climate-resilient measures. making available them and understandable to everyone, while also paying special attention to the social, political, and economic barriers that are commonly found. The actions will be implemented in at least 20 regions and communities, where we will address transformative solutions in the path to climate resilience. Fundão will be one of the case studies.



DesirMED's main objective is to strengthen knowledge and capabilities of Med regions and communities to take leadership and ownership in their transformative CCA pathways and accelerate the implementation of transformative solutions required to increase their resilience over the long term. DesirMED will accelerate the adoption of multi-level and multi-actor-based portfolio of innovative solutions, prioritising NbSs. Fundão will be one of the 5 demonstration regions.



GAME-ER project aims to research the emergence, development, sustainability of local and regional video game clusters in Europe. Thus, it will analyze six clusters in France, the Czech Republic, Italy, Scotland, and Portugal, and conduct a Europe-wide spatial organization study of the video game industry. The project will create an Interactive Methodological Toolkit with policy and practical recommendations for local and national decision-makers to foster and enhance Cultural and Creative Industries clusters. Fundão will be one of the case studies and will deploy a pilot.
