- Dedicated to urban authorities in the EU.
- Open to technical staff and elected officials.
- Financial and expert support from the European Urban Initiative.
- Apply at any time through a rolling call.
- Bottom-up design tailored to specific local urban challenges.
- A flexible tool that cities can use more than once.
