

	<ol> <li>Omställningslabbet - the Transition Lab, a future prototype, and a meeting place to strengthen and explore methods for co-creation and inclusion in sustainable transition. It tests how citizens can actively participate in the transition and how different actors can meet and exchange ideas.</li> <li>Jubileumsparken - a park in the making; agility in urban development. The citizens of Gothenburg have since 2014 been able to take part in temporary activities in Jubileumsparken: sailing, sauna bathing, swimming, skating and much more. This is a new way of urban development - that together with the citizens try out what works before you build something permanently. In August 2022, the first permanent part of Jubileumsparken opened.</li> <li>Tage - circulation of products for the City of Gothenburg Tage is a system for circulation of products between municipal administrations and companies in the City with intermediate storage and transport of gods. Furniture and furnishings, electronics and machines, stationery and working clothes are recycled, among other things. Tage contributes in reducing purchasing costs, climate and environmental impact and the amount of waste in the City, making thus a difference in the work for a circular Gothenburg.</li> </ol>
