













### Who are we?




- Eriges is the « Régie communale autonome » of Seraing, which is responsible for implementing the Master Plan for the Seraing Valley:

  - a green zone plan



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


- Our missions

**ERIGES** took part in the European **ALT/BAU** project

Theme: The reactivation of vacant and deteriorated buildings resulting from social, economic and demographic changes.

Thanks to ALT BAU, concrete actions have been implemented, including:

- An inventory of vacant and deteriorated housing
- Contacting around 100 homeowners to find out how we can support them and help them with the process
- The creation of a Housing Centre, "Pôle Habitat", to support homeowners, tenants, sellers and buyers in all their administrative procedures relating to housing, renovation, sale or rental.



#### **ERIGES** took part in the European **Vilawatt** project

Theme: **improving energy governance** at local level and encouraging **new energy renovation projects in the area**, by setting up a one-stop service providing key energy services for everyone (public, private, businesses, citizens):

- 100% renewable energy supply
- energy audits
- training and awareness-raising for citizens
- energy-efficient renovation of buildings
- creation of a local currency linked to energy savings.

## Local Energy Renovation Platform

- → In 2022, **ERIGES** set up a **Local Energy Renovation Platform** in collaboration with the Seraing Housing and Energy Centre.
- → This project is subsidised 75% by the SPW and 25% by the City of Seraing.
- → This is a free support service for all Sérésiens and Flémallois wishing to undertake energy renovation work.



#### Pollecs audit and self-insulation

#### → POLLEC audit:

- Citizens registered at the Platform and in income category 1 (the lowest) benefit from a free audit, giving them access to housing allowances and reduced-rate loans from Wallonia.
- 60 households benefited from this free audit.
- The aim is not only to finance the audit, but also to ensure that its implementation is monitored through the Platform.

#### → POLLEC self-insulation:

- Around forty residents will benefit from theoretical and practical training as well as personalised support to enable them to insulate their roofs or attic floors themselves.
- The trainer was appointed under a public procurement contract and 17 candidates have already taken part
- The aim of taking part in this project is to help applicants who want to carry out insulation work themselves, while ensuring that the work is of high quality and eligible for Wallonia grants.

#### Rénobatex

#### → Call for projects Rénobatex :

- → In 2023, Wallonia launched the RÉNOBATEX call for projects to support innovative ideas for removing obstacles to renovation or contributing to energy sobriety.
- → As part of Wallonia's recovery plan, this call for proposals has a budget of €15 million, from which a maximum of 30 projects may be selected.
- → The project proposed by Eriges involves developing a comprehensive methodology to mobilise, encourage and actively support owners of unoccupied homes to renovate their properties in Seraing and Flémalle.
- → This method consists of four parts designed to:
- identify vacant homes
- inform owners
- help with decision-making
- actively support households throughout the renovation (via the Plateform)
- Each strand will benefit from specific tools and methods to achieve the objectives set. The project submitted by Eriges covers a period of 30 months and requires a grant of €299,369.

On 7 May 2024, following a decision by the Walloon Government, ERIGES received approval for this Renobatex project to address unoccupied buildings, starting on 1 July 2024, for a period of 30 months.
